


NORLEY PRIMARY SCHOOL NEWSLETTER




CORONATION CELEBRATIONS

GUINEA PIGS




If anyone would like to take the guinea pigs home for the weekend then please contact the school office. They are a delight and very easy to look after.



THANK YOU



Class 1 made beautiful floating jellyfish




Class 3 enjoyed looking for the hidden animals when their classroom was turned into a rainforest.
