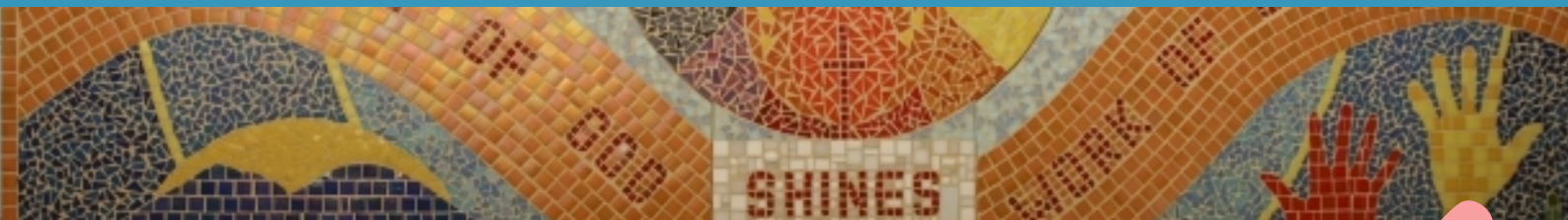

PTFA CAMPING NIGHT



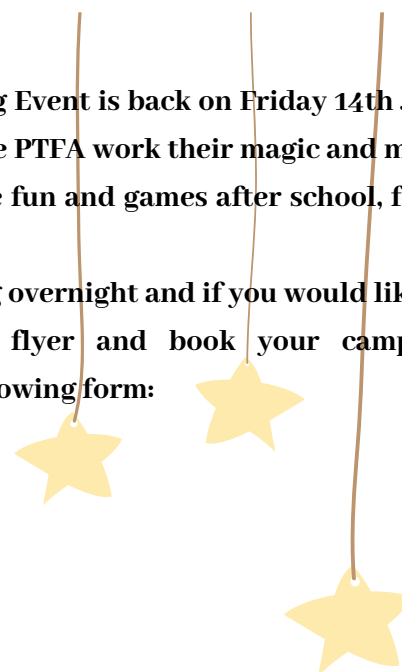

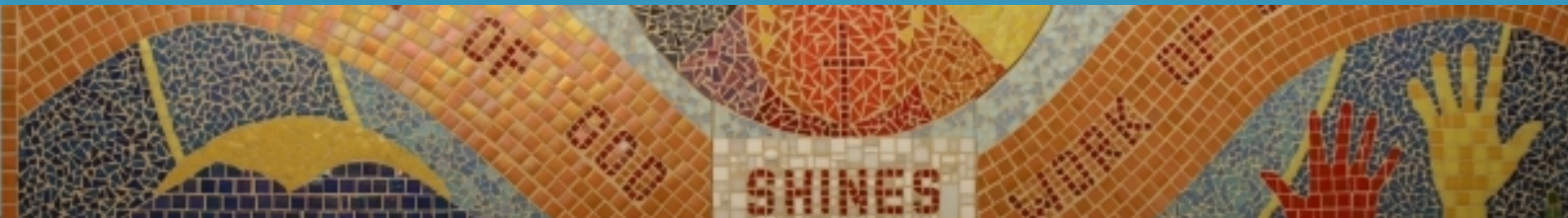


UNAUTHORISED ABSENCES

DAD'S READING AFTERNOON

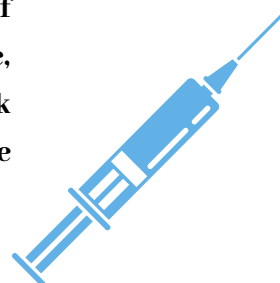

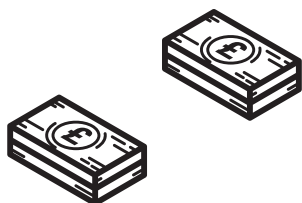
GUINEA PIGS



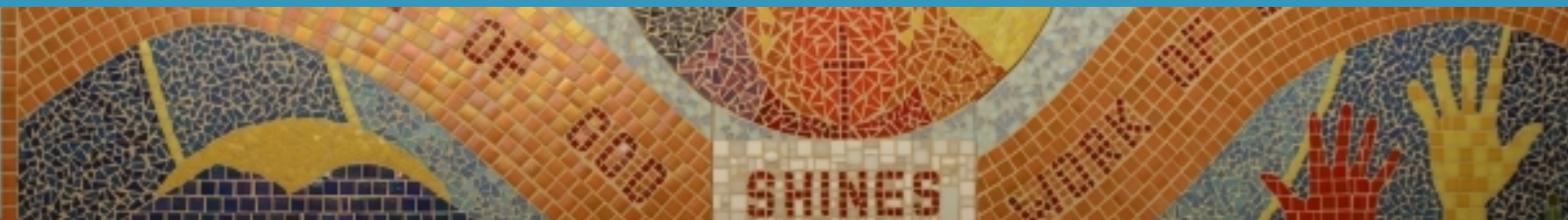
If anyone would like to take the guinea pigs home for the weekend then please contact the school office. They are a delight and very easy to look after.
