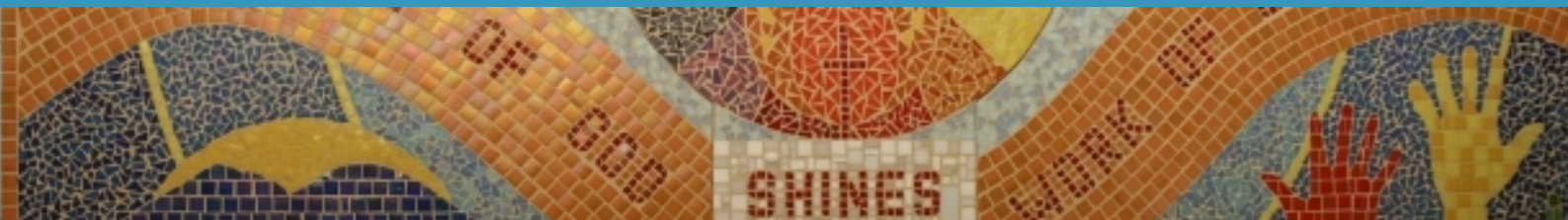


HAPPY NEW YEAR

All homework and a termly letter can be found on the individual class pages of our website. If you have any queries or need to speak to the class teachers, please contact the school office and we will be happy to help.

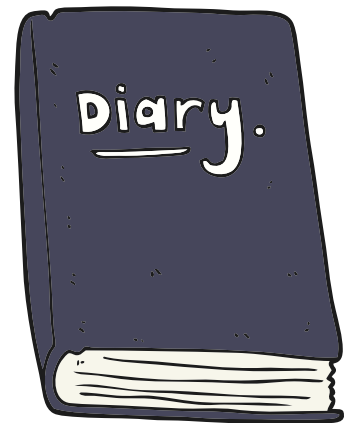


FLYERS
