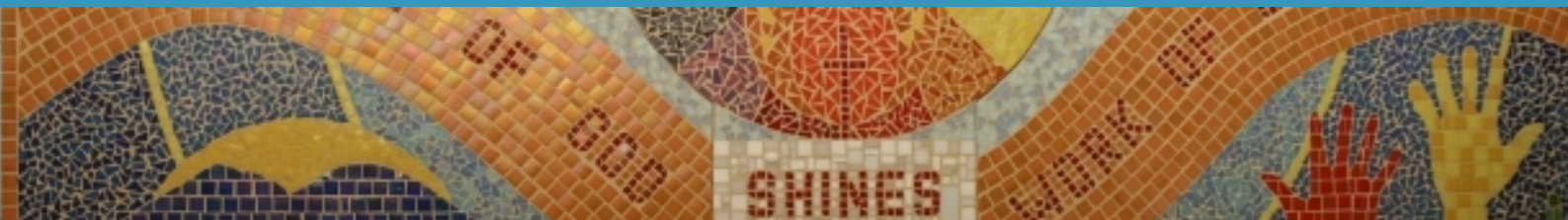

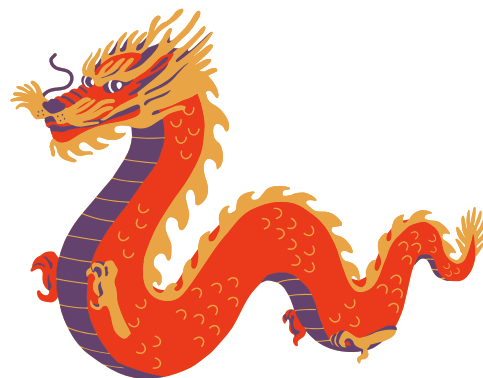


UNAUTHORISED ABSENCES

MEASLES



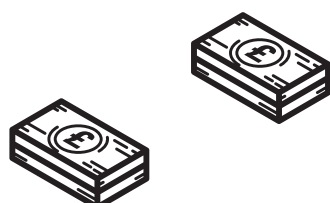

OUTSTANDING BALANCES

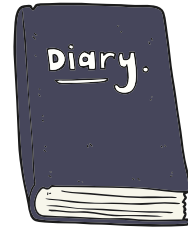
