ATTENDANCE

Recent Government data research shows that pupils who performed better both at the end of primary and secondary school missed fewer days than those who didn't perform as well. For example, data shows that 84% of Key Stage 2 pupils who had 100% attendance achieved the expected standard, compared to 40% of pupils who were persistently absent across the key stage.
