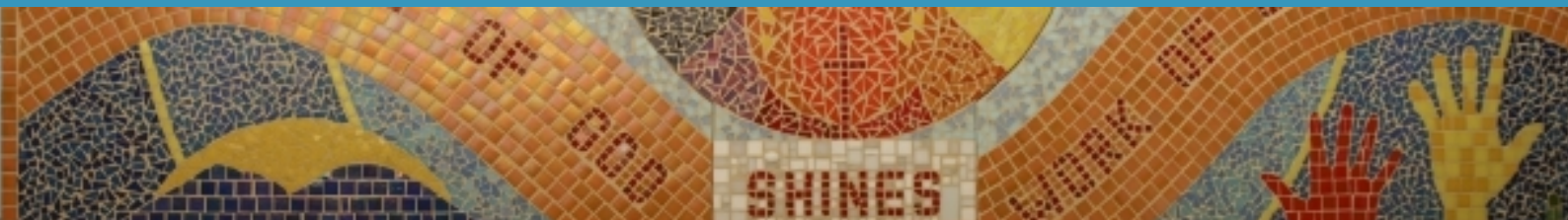
We'd also love the children to join in the spirit of the day by coming to school dressed in 1940s-style clothing. Suggestions include:
