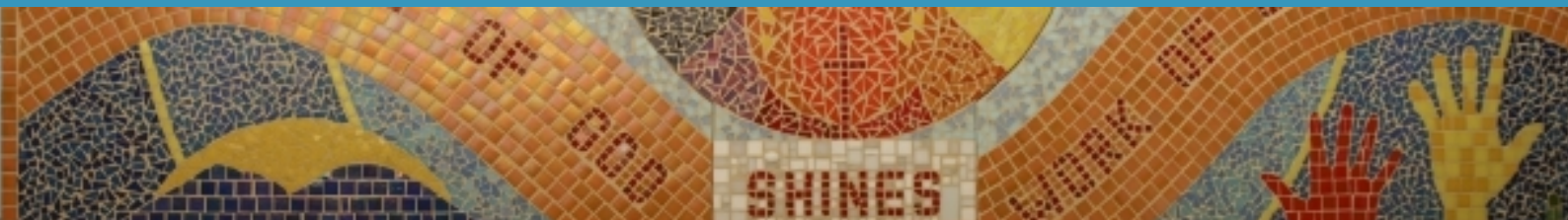
Please bring your own chairs, as we only have a limited number available for use on the field.
