#### How this may affect you

- Our standard working hours will be between 8am and 6pm Monday to Friday. Our team may need to work later in the day or over the weekend during this period. The traffic management will need to remain in place throughout the duration of the work.
- There may be an increase in noise and construction traffic as we carry out the work.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained where possible and signed diversions to direct vehicles around our working areas will be in place and checked regularly.
- On completion, the road will be reinstated and the traffic management removed.
- Your water and wastewater services will not be affected and can continue to be used as normal during our work.
